AFJROTC UK-073 Operating Instruction 36-01

SUBJECT: Uniforms and Awards

PURPOSE: This operating instruction supplements guidance contained in the AFJROTC Uniform and Awards Guide dated 1 September 2007.

1. Ribbons will be worn IAW AFJROTC guidance. Local criteria for wear is as follows:
 - a. The Dress and Appearance Ribbon is awarded to cadets who wear the uniform on all designed uniform days during a semester and have a 90% average on uniform scores.
 - b. The Recruiting Ribbon is awarded for recruiting at least two cadets during a semester.
 - c. The Activities Ribbon is awarded for participation in one local parade or event.
 - d. The Attendance Ribbon is awarded for having no more than four excused absences and no unexcused absences during a semester. Three tardies will count as an unexcused absence.
 - e. The Service Ribbon is awarded for 20 or more documented hours of community service.
 - f. The E2C Ribbon is awarded for achieving a minimum of 70% on the six core E2C exercises. An additional ribbon with appropriate accouterments is awarded for cadets achieving 80% or above on the six core E2C exercises.

2. Uniforms will be worn IAW AFJROTC guidance. Local criteria for wear is as follows:
 - a. The silver name tag is required and must be purchased by the cadet.
 - b. BDUs are optional and must be purchased by the cadet. Unit patches will be provided. Donated BDU uniforms are available upon request.
