
MEMORANDUM FOR ALL CADETS

SUBJECT: UK-073 Operating Instruction 36-01

PURPOSE: This Operating Instruction supplements guidance contained in the UK-073 Uniform and Awards Guide dated 25 October 2012.

1. Ribbons will be worn IAW AFJROTC guidance. Local wear criteria is as follows:
 - a. The Dress and Appearance Ribbon is awarded to cadets who wear the uniform on all designated uniform days during the semester and have a 95% average on scores.
 - b. The Recruiting Ribbon is awarded for recruiting at least 2 cadets during a semester.
 - c. The Activities Ribbon is awarded for participation in one parade or local event.
 - d. The Attendance Ribbon is awarded for having 3 excused absences or less and no unexcused absences during a semester. Three tardies count as an unexcused absence.
 - e. The Service Ribbon is awarded for 20 or more hours of community service.
 - f. The Health and Wellness Ribbon is awarded to all cadets who participate in the Presidential Physical Fitness Program and achieve 50% or more on the overall score. Devices are awarded based on percentile levels achieved contained in the Uniform Guide.
2. Uniforms will be worn IAW AFJROTC guidance. Local wear criteria is as follows:
 - a. The blue and silver name tags are required to be worn. The unit will buy the first of each name tag. The cadet is responsible to buy replacement name tags if needed.
 - b. BDUs are optional and must be obtained by the cadet. Unit and AFJROTC patches will be provided. Donated BDU uniforms are available upon request.
